## Undergraduate Financial Aid for SCCC Alumni

The Brentwood Campus of Long Island University offers the following selection of grants and scholarships to alumni of Suffolk County Community College. These awards do not need to be repaid. Our goal is to help you graduate with minimal debt and to receive a quality, private education.

### SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE ALUMNUS AWARD

This award is a 40 percent tuition discount scholarship awarded to SCCC associate degree recipients for the duration of their first bachelor's degree studies at the Brentwood Campus of Long Island University. This award is not based on financial need. A student who receives this scholarship must maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative grade point average to continue receiving the award.

### ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

A transfer student with an associate degree and a minimum GPA of 2.75 will be considered for this scholarship, which ranges from \$250 - \$2,500 per academic year (see chart below). The award is available to full-time and part-time students. A student who receives this scholarship must maintain at least a 3.2 cumulative grade point average to continue receiving the award.

### TRANSFER OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM

The Brentwood Campus offers this special program for economically challenged students. Participating students receive financial aid packages equivalent to full need as determined through the financial aid application process. Contact the Office of Financial Aid for details. This award cannot be combined with the Hardship Award.

### HARDSHIP AWARD

The Brentwood Campus offers this special award for students who demonstrate need under extenuating financial circumstances. Students must provide a letter explaining their financial hardship situation along with supporting documentation to the Office of Financial Aid. This award cannot be combined with the Transfer Opportunity Program.

### NOTE:

This award selection is available to qualified applicants who transfer to the Brentwood Campus of Long Island University in the Fall 2011 semester or later. The minimum registration for scholarship eligibility is six credits per semester. All students must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
